



As you may be aware, Chennai, Cuddalore, Kanchipuram and few other districts of Tamilnadu experienced unusual rains in Nov & Dec 2015 which resulted in sudden flooding that led to large scale damage to people and their properties, especially those in the low income segments, settlement along the waterways and low lying areas, 10-18 ft of water flooded and destroyed or washed away huts, sheds and destroyed all household articles and also their livelihood assets.

Volunteerism was seen at its best, people of all ages, irrespective of caste creed, religion came forward on their own, contributed funds, purchased relief materials and travelled to Chennai, Cuddalore and other parts of Tamilnadu to provide relief to people who were worst affected. Equitas with the strength of staff force and knowledge of the slum affected areas joined in identifying and distributing the relief materials

PHASE I: SORTING & DISTRIBUTION OF ESSENTIAL FOOD WATER

In the first phase the volunteers joined the Government in sorting and distributing the relief materials in an orderly fashion, the strength of Equitas was recognised in easily identifying affected areas and orderly distribution through their SHG network, 200-250 staff of Equitas joined the Government in Nehru stadium in this relief work

Phase II: Health camps

Once the basic requirements were met, the next phase was medical camps, Equitas conducted more than 200 health camps along with Government, Rotary to help prevent spread of any epidemics.



Phase III: Rotary Revive Chennai Project

Revival: Equitas joined Rotary International Dist 3230 to help distribute the revival kit (consisting of stove, mat, dress and groceries (totally 42 items) to more than 6000 most affected families to enable them revive their lives



Phase-IV:

Rehabilitation: Equitas has started giving loans to restart their business after rephasing their existing loans and is working with the families who are being shifted to new permanent structures with conduct health camps, conduct job fairs to get their unemployed youth jobs in their new localities
