Equitas runs Sugam Clinic, an evening clinic for the benefit of low-income households who seek medical help when they come back home in the evening after the day's work, one such clinic was inaugurated at Selaiyur in Tambaram recently. Sugam clinic at BV colony in Perembur celebrated their first year anniversary. Doctors offer quality consultation and health history of every patient is tracked.







Equitas Gyan Kendra Skill Training

Equitas organized skill training program 'Equitas Gyan Kendra' in all branches. The skill development program has helped improve the income of the beneficiaries. A beneficiary from Nashik introduced a new liquid soap product 'Clean Master'. The training had also enabled a member to open a tailoring shop at Mylapore, Chennai. Training to over four lakh women members in vocational skills such as tailoring & embroidery, agarbathi/candle making, detergent/phenyl manufacturing and preparing processed food such as pickles & jams. These training programs are structured as 1-week long programs.



Partnering with Rotary Club

In association with rotary club skill activities like kutch embroidery training programme are conducted. In this programme members have benefited by gaining the skills of how to get self employed. This Programme was done, joining hands with rotary club Mr.Ganesan Rotarian distributed certificates to our EGK Members. 
